Long Branch Horse Retirement

The Long Branch Horse Retirement Program continues to be a source of pride at Long Branch, with currently 75 retired horses in residence on 400 acres, close to the Shenandoah River and the Blue Ridge Mountains.

Four-board fencing, automatic waterers and large run-in sheds are features of the program and our herds are segregated by gender with over two acres per horse.

Our monthly package of \$250 per month includes:

- Regular hoof trims
- Spring and Fall vaccinations
- Yearly dental float
- Hay as needed
